After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the petitioner would surrender before the appellate Court concerned within one week positively and would move an application there for seeking the relief of suspension of her sentence and he further prays that the appellate Court be directed to decide her said application within some specific time frame.

Mr. Iqbal Singh Mann, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has appeared in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to respondent No.1-State in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having

been withdrawn with a direction to the appellate Court concerned that in case the petitioner surrenders before it within the afore-stipulated period and moves any application for seeking the above-mentioned relief, the same be decided in accordance with law, in the given set of the facts and circumstances of the matter, within a period of three (03) days thereafter.
