This petition was filed seeking directions to respondent No. 2- Superintendent of Police, Sonipat to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondents (arrayed in the petition).

As per the pleadings, there is a dispute regarding possession of land between the petitioners and private respondents. The dispute is pending in writ petition bearing CWP No. 8722-1997 and an interim protection is granted therein. There are allegations that the stay order was being violated by the private respondents at the time of harvesting the crop and five FIRs (Annexures P-7, P-9 to P-11 and P-15) were registered against the private respondents at the instance of the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel has filed reply, the same is taken on record. As per the reply, the said FIRs were investigated, challan presented and the accused were released on bail.

From the facts, it is forthcoming that the grievance in this petition is with regard to the violation of interim protection granted by this Court and the fact that the private respondents are not behind the bars.

The petitioners have efficacious remedies for redressal of grievance.

No case is made out for interference under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Since the main case has been dismissed, pending application, if any, renders infructuous.
