Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.144 dated 22.6.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station, Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

By virtue of the order dated 19.7.2021 the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 19.7.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same. It is, however, submitted that the mediation proceedings remained unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for the complainant however opposes the submissions made by counsel for petitioner but has endorsed the fact that mediation proceedings remained unsuccessful.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.7.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
