Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. Counsel further submitted that appellant No.2 as also respondent No.3-proforma respondent (Grandparents of the deceased) have since died and therefore, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Narinder Kaur W/o late Sh. Apwinder Jeet Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.4,50,000/- favouring appellant No.1-Narinder Kaur W/o late Sh. Apwinder Jeet Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 29.03.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
