Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for issuance of a direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7 and further to arrest respondent No.4 in respect of FIR No.68, dated 25.05.2022, under Sections 498-A and 323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana, Annexure P-2. Another prayer has been made for directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to decide representation dated 01.07.2022, Annexure P-3, submitted by petitioner No.1.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she restricts her prayer in the petition to issuance of a direction to the official respondent No.2 to examine representation dated 01.07.2022, Annexure P-3, submitted by petitioner No.1.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Senior DAG,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, and without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to examine representation dated 01.07.2022, Annexure P-3, submitted by petitioner No.1, and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.
