**B.S. Walia, J.** (Oral)

1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.02.2020, in CWP-21237-2017.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 24.02.2020 reveals that CWP-212-37-2017, was disposed of as having become infructuous while observing that in case financial benefits emanating from order dated 11.09.2019, had not been released to the petitioner, the same be made over without any further delay.

3. Learned counsel states that pursuant to notice issued to the respondent, benefits as per entitlement have been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
