The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.123 dated 31.07.2022 under Sections 307, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Ludhiana.

The reply dated 14.11.2022 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated August 22, 2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation. He further submits that the petitioner has been declared innocent during the course of investigation.

In this view of the matter, the present petition is rendered infructuous. However, in case the petitioner is required for investigation at a subsequent stage, then 07 days' advance notice shall be accorded to him in
