Petitioners professing to be landless, marginal and small farmers claim entitlement to allotment of plots under the provisions of Punjab (Welfare and Settlement of Landless, Marginal and Small Occupant Farmers) Allotment of State Government Land Act 2020 (for short 'the Act').

It is submitted that petitioners, fulfilling all eligibility conditions prescribed under the Act, have submitted applications dated 09.09.2021, Annexures P-21 to P-24 before the competent authority for allotment of plots under the Act. However, the authorities are not taking any action on their applications and are not deciding the same.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts the prayer for a decision on applications dated 09.09.2021, Annexures P-21 to P-24, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Jain, Addl.AG., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Advance copy of the writ petition stands served. Learned counsel for the respondents does not raise any objection to the restricted prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide applications dated 09.09.2021, Annexures P-21 to P-24, filed by the petitioners in accordance with law, within three (03) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
