By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.29, dated 21.04.2021, having been registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, Police District Batala, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 21/23/25/27-A/29 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner reiterates that even as per the FIR, the quantity of heroin allegedly recovered from the petitioner (as per the investigating agency), is 50 grams of heroin which is well below commercial quantity, such quantity being above 250 grams.

He also points out that on that ground alone a co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Gulwinder Singh alias Galwinder Singh, has already been admitted to bail by this court on 29.06.2021, vide an order passed in CRM-M-22341-2021.

Upon query to learned State counsel he submits that, as per his instructions, there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
