Prayer in the petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the complaints (Annexures P-1 to P-3) given by the petition against respondent No.5.

Short reply filed on behalf of the respondent-State is already on record.

Learned State counsel points out that as per the short reply, the petitioner had produced an affidavit before SI Rajni Bala that the compromise has been arrived qua the property with her in-laws, but the petitioner had not mentioned any fact qua the commission of rape by her father-in-law Daljit Singh on 19.04.2021. He further points out that even during the inquiry, no evidence qua the committing of rape upon the petitioner by father-in-law came on record.

In view of the above, no further order is called for in the present petition.
