The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case n FIR No.0160 dated 27.08.2021 under Sections 498-A and 406 of the IPC registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are parents-in-law of the complainant and have been falsely implicated in the case in hand on account of temperamental differences between their son and the complainant. Learned counsel further submits that in order to keep the complainant happy and comfortable, they had even provided her with an independent and separate accommodation but it still did not help matters. Learned counsel further submits that in compliance of order dated 29.09.2021, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bakshis Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined

investigation and submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 29.09.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
