[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 11.05.2022 in CRWP No.3888 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRWP No.3888 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the appropriate authorities to consider and decide the legal notice served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] Learned DAG has produced copy of the speaking order dated 05.08.2022 (endorsed on 26.08.2022) rejecting the claim of the petitioner for premature release. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 05.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance

with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
