Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.59 dated 29.04.2022 registered under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural).

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police by virtue of order of interim bail dated 22.08.2022 passed by this Court.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Vikramjit has not disputed the aforesaid fact and further submits that the petitioner

is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

The present case involves version as well as cross version and no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner who has already joined the investigation with the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order granting interim bail dated 22.08.2022 to the petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the condition envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
