Status report by way of an affidavit of Gur Iqbal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Amargarh, District Malerkotla, produces by learned State counsel in the Court today and same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

Relevant paragraph 4 of the status report says as under:

“4. That ASI Jeet Singh has contacted Pardeep Kaur through her father Ram Lal. Said Pardeep Kaur and her children have sent their statement through Whatsapp to him. Pardeep Kaur has stated that her husband Nazar Masih had evicted her from his house along with her children. Then she started residing with her parents at village sihar for the last about 6-7 months. She and her children decided to go to abroad. So now they have gone abroad. Nobody is responsible for her decision. She requested not to harass her parents. Copy of her statement is enclosed as Annexure R-3/T. She has also sent copies of her passport as well as

copies of pass ports of her children. Passport no. of Pardeep Kaur is V8452964, No. V8446043 of Reeve and No V8974274 of Rovin Masih. The above said copies reveal the departure of Pardeep Kaur and her children from Airport Amritsar on 07-08-2022 and arrival was in UAE Dubai on 07-08-2022. She has also sent copies of Air Tickets, Copy of her statement, Copy of her Passport and her children's Passport. Copy of passport of Pardeep Kaur is enclosed as Annexure R-4/T."

After going through the stand of respondent No. 5 i.e. wife of the petitioner as explained in aforementioned para 4 of the status report, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, petitioner is free to seek appropriate remedy available to him, in accordance with law.
