The present petition has been filed seeking writ in the nature of habeas corpus for appointment of the Warrant Officer to get released the alleged detainee namely, Anju Bala, daughter of the petitioner, who is stated to be in the illegal custody of respondents No.5 to 10.

Learned State counsel informs this Court that after great difficulty, the police was able to recover the girl, alleged detainee namely, Anju Bala from the house of the petitioner itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 04.1.2022, the girl came to the house of the petitioner and was crying and within fifteen minutes, the police arrived and took the girl for getting her statement recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the parties agreed that in the statement recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C before the Magistrate, the alleged detenue, who is major in age, stated that she had gone of her own accord with respondent No.5 and thereafter, no further proceedings were undertaken and the girl was left at the place of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above, no further grievance of the petitioner survives, at this stage and the present petition may be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
