The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for seeking directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to investigate the case pertaining to FIR No.0141 dated 01.04.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307, 341 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act at Police Godpuri in a fair and impartial manner and to file a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. against all the accused named by the complainant in the FIR.

The learned State counsel has filed a status report by way of an affidavit of Anil Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwal dated 10.09.2022 and the same is taken on record. As per para 10 of the affidavit, Anil and Yogesh have been arrested and a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted against them and the case has been fixed for consideration on framing of charge. So far as the co-accused of Anil and Yogesh are concerned

namely, Raju son of Virender, Mahesh son of Lekhi, Rohit son of Kishan, Anangpal son of Lakhmi and Krishan son of Maniram they are said to be evading arrest and raids are being made at their probable places of hideouts on the basis of secret information. However, they have not yet been traced but consistent efforts are being made to trace them.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

It is expected that the Investigating Agency shall trace the said five accused and initiate appropriate proceedings against them upon their arrest.
