Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 0299 dated 25.07.2021, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, Faridabad and and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 17.02.2022, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 09.03.2022 of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Faridabad has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Faridabad. Learned Magistrate has stated that the compromise arrived

at between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 0299 dated 25.07.2021, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, Faridabad along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
