Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the
same is allowed and Annexures P-7 to P-10 are permitted to be taken on
record.

CWP-18923-2018

Present petition has been filed for the grant of service benefits
to the petitioner as well as the retiral benefits along with interest.

As per the averments made in the petition, though the petitioner
retired from service on 31.03.2017 but he was not given certain service
benefits such as 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP. The further grievance of the petitioner

is that he has not been given the benefits of earned leave as per his entitlement as well as the other retiral benefits and therefore, appropriate direction be issued to the respondents to grant the service benefits, retiral benefits as well as interest upon the delayed release of the same.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply and status report dated 14.01.2020 wherein, it has been mentioned that all the service benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for, have already been released and a sum of Rs.19,12,901/- has been released apart from the GIS amounting to Rs.41,736/- as well as General Provident Fund amounting to Rs.22,48,412/-. It has been further mentioned in the status report that a sum of Rs.8,59,040/- has been paid to the petitioner as leave encashment and the arrears of pay for which the petitioner is found entitled for to the tune of Rs.21,617/- has also been released to the petitioner along with arrears of increments amounting to Rs.9,591/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the payments have been made but the said payments have been made after incorrect calculations for which the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 03.09.2020 (Annexure P-8) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation is received and has not been decided so far, appropriate order on the same will be passed by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
