This is a first petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.231 dated 07.12.2021, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the petitioner is in custody since 10.12.2021, thus, has prayed that the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the U.T., Chandigarh

has stated that out of total 16 prosecution witnesses, 4 have been examined, 6 witnesses have been given up and thus, 6 witnesses remain to be examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

The trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and to conclude the same as expeditiously as possible.
