The present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR N.308 dated
31.05.2022 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station City
Panipat.

Arrest of the petitioner was stayed vide order dated 06.09.2022.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits
that in case the Investigating Agency requires the petitioner to appear, he
shall make himself available without any demur.

The petition is allowed, subject to compliance enshrined under

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall surrender his passport with the Investigating Officer and
4. That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

However, it is clarified that if the petitioner does not join the investigation as required by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, this interim order shall be deemed to have been vacated.
