1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.09.2021 in CWP-17633-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 08.09.2021 reveals that CWP-17633-2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to consider the case of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 22.03.2021 as also by taking into account the plea raised in the CWP and take a decision in respect thereto in accordance with law expeditiously but not later than six months from 08.09.2021.

3. Compliance report along with speaking order Annexure R-1 dated 09.09.2022 has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof, states that in view of the speaking order Annexure R-1 dated 09.09.2022 rejecting the grievance of the petitioners, the petitioners are

withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order Annexure R-1 dated 09.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
