This petition was filed seeking quashing of order dated 12.2.2021 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala in Complaint bearing No. “COMA/5196/2017 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, declaring petitioner as proclaimed person.

On 1.11.2021, following order was passed:

“Notice of motion for 2.12.2021.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Malik, Dy. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1-State. Requisite number of copies of the paper books be handed over to him during the course of the day.

*Respondents No. 2 and 3 be served through **dasti** process, for the date fixed.*

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial court within a fortnight from today, in which event, he shall be released on an interim bail to the satisfaction of the said Court/Duty Magistrate concerned subject to an undertaking that he shall also pay costs of Rs.5000/- to the Private Respondents before the date fixed in this court.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI-Manpreet Singh has produced order dated 2.11.2021 passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala which is reproduced below:

“ File put up on the application for accepting and attesting the bail bonds. Along with the application the learned counsel for the applicant has also produced certified copy of order dated 1.11.2021 passed in CRM-M-40740-2021 of the Hon'ble High Court, whereby applicant was ordered to be released on interim bail. In view thereof, applicant is admitted on interim bail on furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.1 lakh with one surety in the like amount. Requisite bonds furnished, which have been accepted and attested. Notice to complainant be issued for 2.12.2021.”

In view of the order reproduced above, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of as infructuous.
