Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of order dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, U.T.Chandigarh in a complaint No.102/2019 titled as 'Natasha Gill Vs. Rajbir Singh Uberoi and another', filed under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Heard counsel for the petitioner.

Petitioner had approached the Trial Court with an application seeking permission to travel abroad from 09.08.2022 to 27.08.2022. With the efflux of time, the prayer made has become infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is a businessman, keeps on travelling abroad and was granted permission on an earlier occasion, vide order dated 04.04.2022 (Annexure P-9) to visit Dubai

and South Africa. He submits that the petitioner is likely to travel again in near future and may be granted liberty to file a application before the Trial Court with a new travel schedule.

Request has been considered.

Petitioner is granted liberty to approach the Trial Court with a fresh application alongwith his travel itinerary. In case a fresh application is filed by the petitioner, the Trial Court shall consider it on its merit, uninfluenced by order dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-1), whereby, the previous application was rejected.

Petition is disposed of.
