AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 360 dated 20.8.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 474, 198, 201 and 120-B IPC and Section 12(1)(b) of Passport Act, 1967, Sections 7, 8 and 12 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and Sections 66-C and 66-D of the Information Technology Act, 2000.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within three weeks from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within three weeks from today
