This is an application filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case from 30.08.2022 to an early date.

Notice in the application.

On advance notice, Mr. Sarabjit S. Cheema, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/State of Punjab

and has submitted that he has no objection in case the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 30.08.2022 to today itself for final disposal.

In view of the aforesaid facts and no objection from the opposite side, the present application is allowed and the main Criminal revision petition is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

Challenge in the present Criminal revision petition is to the order dated 08.04.2019 vide which the charges have been framed against the petitioner and co-accused Pinder Singh.

Learned State Counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that in the present case, several witnesses have already been examined.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Criminal revision with liberty to the petitioners to take up all the points which have been raised in the present Criminal Revision as well as those available to them during the course of trial before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further prayed that since the petitioners are ladies and they are married and have minor children to take care of, thus, their personal appearance before the trial Court may kindly be exempted.

In view of the above, the present Criminal Revision is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to take up all the points which have been raised in the present Criminal Revision as well as

those available to them during the course of trial before the trial Court.

The petitioners being ladies having minor children to take care of, thus, their personal appearance before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioners shall be represented through their counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute their identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;
- vi) any other condition which the trial Court may impose.
