[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 17.02.2022 in CWP No.3023 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.3023 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the Director, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab to consider and decide representation dated 26.08.2021 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG has produced copy of speaking order dated 16.08.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioner as raised in representation dated 26.08.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 16.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance

with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
