Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 152 dated 11.08.2021, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Vide order dated 24.05.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gulab Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.
