Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned transfer order dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-15) *qua* petitioners vide which they have been transferred from the post of Assistant Education Officers (AEO) to the post of Demonstrator in Physical Education (DPE).

2. Following stand has been taken in para Nos.2 and 3 in reply filed on behalf of the respondents:

“2. That in this regard it is submitted that many Assistant Education Officers who were transferred like the petitioner have filed the writ petitions challenging their transfer orders in:-

(i) CWP No.21677 of 2017 Jagdish Singh Vs. State of Haryana & others.

(ii) CWP No.21328 of 2017 Ramesh Chander & others Vs. State of Haryana & others.

Both these writ petitions were fixed for 04.10.2017 and at the time of hearing, this Hon'ble Court was apprised that the matter has been examined and reviewed by the Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana, School Education, Department on 03.10.2017 and decided that the policy for posting of AEOs in the office of District Education Officers for managing the Sports Activities in the districts, is being reviewed.

Meanwhile AEOs who were posted in the DEO Offices and have been transferred, their orders be deemed as cancelled for the time being. After reviewing of the policy (regarding posting of AEOs in O/o DEO), the transfers would be carried out.

In view of the above, both the writ petitions were disposed off on the same day i.e. 04.10.2017.

3. That in compliance of the above mentioned position, transfer order dated 06.09.2017 were cancelled vide this office order No. 17/137-2017 HRM-I(3) dated 10.10.2017 (Annexure R-1) and the name of the petitioners and the No. of present writ petition i.e. 20946 of 2017 has also been considered and mentioned in the order dated 10.10.2017. Therefore, the transfer order of the petitioners has already been cancelled and the present writ petition has become infructuous.”

3. In view of the aforesaid, nothing survives for adjudication by this Court.

4. Disposed of as infructuous.
