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RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 & 3 to join the petitioner in Army services, after completion of his 14 months training. The petitioner was discharged on 28.02.2017 without giving any kind of notice; along with certain other prayers.

The counsel for the respondents-UOI has pointed out that the petitioner has already filed a petition before the Armed Forces Tribunal, Chandigarh vide Annexure R-3, annexed with the written statement, accordingly, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.

Even the counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, this court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition. The same is dismissed.

However, dismissal of the present petition, per se, shall not have any adverse effect on the petition pending before the Armed Forces Tribunal, Chandigarh. The same shall be decided independently, as per the law.

All the pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
