[1] Prayer in the petition is for taking action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 25.09.2018 in LPA No.2465 of 2016 in case titled as 'Rameshwar Dass and others versus State of Punjab and others'.

[2] Learned Counsel contends that LPA No.2465 of 2016 was disposed of vide order dated 25.09.2018 but needful in terms thereof has not been done, therefore, the instant petition was filed. Today, orders dated 08.02.2022 and 30.03.2022 have been produced by the learned Addl. AG, Punjab and copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that as per order dated 08.02.2022, the petitioners have been found entitled to certain benefits but the financial benefits accruing thereto have yet to be released whereas vide order dated 30.03.2022, claim of petitioner Nos.7 & 8 has been rejected.

[5] Learned counsel states that in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition but respondent No.3 be directed to release

the benefits to the petitioners as per entitlement determined vide order dated 08.02.2022 in a time bound manner and liberty be granted to petitioner Nos.7 & 8 to challenge order dated 30.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[6] The same is not opposed to by the learned Addl. AG, Punjab.

[7] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to petitioner Nos.7 & 8 to challenge order dated 30.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law and also by directing the respondents to ensure release of benefits admissible to the petitioners as per their entitlement in terms of orders dated 08.02.2022 in accordance with law within 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
