[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-9) dated 20.01.2020 in ROR No.161 of 2012-13.

[2] As per order, Annexure P-9 passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, the respondent who is accused by the petitioner of having murdered her husband in respect of which FIR No. 95 dated 05.05.2010 stands registered against her at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib, Punjab, was restrained from creating any third party rights on the land owned by her deceased husband till she was acquitted / discharged by a competent criminal court and that mutation would be sanctioned subject to the above rider.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that entry dated 21.09.2021 and 01.02.2022 by the Patwari concerned does not fully comply with order (Annexure P-9), but now the same has been rectified vide entry Rapat No.261 dated 15.02.2022 in continuity of letter

No.753/peshi dated 01.02.2022 of the Sub Division Officer (C)-cum-Assistant Collector, 1st Grade Jagadhari regarding letter No.791/peshi dated 14.02.2022 marked Naib Tehsildar, Saraswati Nagar dated 14.02.2022, and entry of mutation has been entered in compliance of order in ROR No.161/2012-13 of the Financial Commissioner, Haryana and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
