MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 6.9.2021 under Sections 323, 406, 498A, 354-A IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Women, Ambala, District Ambala.

Learned counsel inter alia contends that it was essentially due to some minor matrimonial differences that the present FIR came to be registered against the petitioner wherein the complainant-wife arrayed as respondent No.2 levelled false allegations of harassment. He submits that the complainant-wife was living happily with him which is apparent from the fact that she was in her matrimonial home when she delivered a baby boy on 25.01.2021. He submits that it was only thereafter once she went to her parental home after the birth of the child that on account of some misunderstanding she got the FIR in question registered.

AS per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the parties have amicably settled their dispute.
