Notice of the application to the non-applicant/respondents.

On asking, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on
behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the prayer made.

For the reasons mentioned in the application and in view of the
fair stand taken by the other side, same is allowed; main case is postponed
from 15.02.2023; and taken on Board today itself.

Main case

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the
Constitution for quashing of order impugned dated 28.01.2013 (P-3) passed
by respondent No.3, whereby, petitioner was dismissed from the post of
Warder; further challenge is to the orders dated 20.06.2013 (P-5) as well as

20.10.2016 (P-12), passed respondent No.2 affirming the aforesaid order.

Parties were heard at length.

Since order dated 27.04.2015 (R-1) passed by respondent No.1 is not under challenge; therefore, even on this ground, the prayer of petitioner cannot be accepted.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioner, wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh with better particulars, including challenging the aforesaid order (R-1) as well, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
