VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for quashing of FIR No.160 dated 31.08.2019, under Sections 307, 336,
324, 323, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms
Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar and all
the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

No body has appeared on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3
in support of the compromise.

From the above-said fact, *prima facie*, it seems that the
compromise has not fructified between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, in view of the above,

seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition in case the compromise is effectual and the parties are ready to make their statements in respect of the said compromise.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

It is made clear that the second petition, if any, filed by the petitioners, would be considered independently on its merit, in accordance with law.
