[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 16.09.2019 in CWP No.20868 of 2019.

[3] Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 16.09.2019, CWP No.20050 of 2019 and other connected petitions were disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the allotment of the General Provident Fund numbers to the petitioners within 60 days and on account of the failure of the respondents to do the needful, the instant petition was filed.

[4] Learned State counsel has filed speaking order dated 27.12.2021 allotting General Provident Fund numbers to the petitioners.

The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel

not wish to pursue the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
