The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the hands of the accused persons/respondent Nos.4 to 6, who are threatening the petitioner and her family members to face the dire consequences, if the FIR No.310 dated 29.11.2019, under Sections 420, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, Tehsil Phagwara, District Kapurthala, is not withdrawn.

Reply by way of affidavit of Paramjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phagwara, District Kapurthala has been filed, as per which Amarjeet Singh had already been arrested on

03.01.2020 and the main accused-Mukesh Kumar has been declared as proclaimed offender on 28.10.2020 by the trial Court. The respondent No.6 namely Rohan Shukla was never made an accused in the said FIR and was not arrested.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the instant petition. The same is dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
