[1] This order shall decide COCP No.1670 of 2022 and 46 other connected matters as the point in issue in all cases is identical. However, for the sake of brevity, facts of the case are being taken from COCP No.1670 of 2022.

[2] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 25.05.2022 in CWP No.11394 of 2022 in case titled as Sweety Pandey vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[3] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.11394 of 2022 was disposed of on the assurance of the learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana that the representation of the petitioner(s) would be considered and decided by the respondent-authorities in accordance with law expeditiously, likely within two weeks by passing a reasoned order, which would be communicated to the petitioner(s).

[4] Learned DAG has produced copy of order dated 30.06.2022 rejecting the representation filed by the petitioner(s) which he states, has been supplied to all the petitioners,. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner(s) who on perusal thereof states that in view of the claim of the petitioner(s) as contained in

the representation dated 20.12.2021 having been rejected, the

petitioner(s) do not press the instant petition(s) and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 30.06.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner(s), the petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner(s) as prayed for.

[6] Rule discharged.
