This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members including minor children at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has moved a representation (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur and no decision on the same has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3- State only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Arun Luthra, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police,

Ferozepur to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order as per law preferably within a month from the date of passing of this order. Ordered accordingly.
