In the present case, prayer of the petitioner is for dissolving the Managing Committee of respondent No.2-SAGAVI CGHS, Gurugram, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the conduct of respondent No.2, the appropriate order needs to be passed by the authorities concerned under the Haryana Co-operative Societies Act, 1984.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the same grievance has also been raised by the petitioner before the Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Gurugram, Haryana, by filing representation dated 21.09.2020 (Annexure P-8), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.1 to decide the said representation dated 21.09.2020, by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned State counsel raises no objection, in case prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted and representation dated 21.09.2020 (Annexure P-8) is directed to be decided by respondent No.1 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in the representation dated 21.09.2020 (Annexure P-8), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the representation dated 21.09.2020 (Annexure P-8), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

It is made clear that respondent No.2 be given an opportunity of hearing in accordance with law before passing of the said order by respondent No.1.
