Petitioner claims himself to be a Sevadar at the Samadh of Ishar Dass and that the revenue entries regarding the said Samadh had been fraudulently changed. In this regard, he has submitted a representation dated 13.05.2022 (Annexure P-6) to respondent Nos.3 to 5 and would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to look into the said representation and decide the same in accordance with law. However, there is no receipt of the said representation.

Since, there is no receipt of the representation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will submit a fresh representation to respondent No.3 for the redressal of his grievance.

Notice of motion

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vishnav Gandhi, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and states that in case, any representation is filed on behalf of the petitioners, the same will be considered and decided in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid submission made on behalf of the petitioner, in case, the petitioner submits a fresh representation to

respondent No.3, respondent No.3 is requested to look into the same and decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
