The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 18.5.2021 under Section 376 IPC and sections 6 and 4 of POCSO Act registered at Police Station, Aur, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 19.5.2021.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined by the learned Trial Court and the case is fixed for arguments.

Learned State counsel submits that out of the total 17 prosecution witnesses 14 have already been examined.

In view of the above position, this court is of the view that trial being at the fag end, this is not the appropriate stage for entertaining this petition, however, learned Trial Court is requested to expedite the proceedings pending before it.
