At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case legal notice dated 02.09.2021 is considered as a representation and disposed of by passing a speaking order within the stipulated time, in light of the decision rendered in CWP-27130-2019 titled as *Shavinder Singh vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and others*, dated 31.05.2022.

Notice of motion to the limited extent.

Mr. Simarandeep S. Sandhu, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He submits that there is no objection to the limited prayer made for consideration and decision on the legal notice/representation in a time bound manner.

Heard counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition or legal notice dated 02.09.2021 (Annexure P-8), respondent No.2 is directed to consider and pass

a speaking order, in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that if any benefits/amount is found due to the petitioner, the same would be released to her within a period of six weeks thereafter as per law.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
