At the outset learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the case of the petitioners would be squarely covered by the decision rendered in CWP-27130-2019 titled *Shavinder Singh vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and others*, dated 31.05.2022.

It is further to submit that even in those cases where adverse orders have been passed, the Corporation had assured the Court that they would relook into the matter and the orders already passed declining the claim of the petitioners would not be taken into account in case the employees makes out for the representation which is to be submitted after the passing of the order in the said case.

Notice of motion to the limited extent.

Mr. Deep Inder Walia, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service. He submits that there is no objection to the limited prayer sought to be made in view of the above noticed

submissions for consideration and decision in terms of the concession given in CWP-27130-2019 and in other 197 cases.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the present petition or in the legal notice dated 28.05.2017 (Annexure P-5), respondent No.2 is directed to consider and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that if any benefits/amount is found due to the petitioners, the same would be released to them within a period of six weeks thereafter, as per law.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of CWP-27130-2019.
