RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for respondent-NMC submits that though the action of the NMC granting permission to the respondent-college(s) has been challenged, the Commission has examined and inspected the college(s) on three occasions latest on 14.10.2020 and has found that the college(s) has removed all deficiencies apart from certain minor deficiencies in respect of which the intake capacity of the respondent-college(s) was reduced to 100 students for the academic session 2020-21. He submits that in such circumstances, even otherwise nothing survives for adjudication in the petition as the Commission has taken the necessary steps in accordance with

law. It is further submitted that the petitioners have already passed out and, therefore, it appears that they are no longer interested in pursuing the matter.

Be that as it may, as it is observed that nobody has been appearing for the petitioners since the last several dates and none has appeared even today, the petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
