The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in FIR No. 403, dated 19.05.2022, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 341, 307, 506 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 307 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act has been deleted and Section 326 IPC has been added during investigation) registered at Police Station, Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that neither any specific injury nor any specific role has been attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner was arrested on 20.05.2022 on the disclosure statement made by his co-accused. Moreover, during investigation Section 307 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act have been deleted and Section 326 IPC is added.

The custody certificate of the petitioner filed by the Counsel for the State is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has

undergone the sentence of 02 months and 24 days by now.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail on the ground that the petitioner was armed with 'lathi' and all the accused gave lathi blows.

Considering the facts that the investigation in the present case is complete; no recovery is to be made; challan stands presented; and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time; petitioner is granted bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
