Mr. Rishabh Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and filed his memorandum of appearance. The same is taken on record.

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the third respondent/Competent Authority would consider and take a decision on the legal notice dated 16.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within the stipulated time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, this petition be disposed of with directions in the said terms and claim made in the legal notice dated 16.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) be decided by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without expressing any opinion or going into the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition or in

the legal notice, respondent No.3/Competent Authority is directed to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice dated 16.07.2022 (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that in case, after the decision, petitioner is found entitled for any benefits, the same be paid to him within a period of four weeks thereafter, as per law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
