The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking regular bail in FIR No. 283, dated 05.07.2022, under Sections 379 and 411 IPC and Section 136 of the Electricity Act, 2003, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner is only with regard to theft of a copper coil from a Transformer. He submits that the allegation is not serious.

The custody certificate of the petitioner filed by the Counsel for the State is taken on record. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has undergone the sentence of 01 month and 13 days, by now. Learned State counsel has opposed the bail on the ground that petitioner is involved in as many as five more cases of similar nature. As per the custody certificate out of five cases, in three cases the petitioner is on bail.

Considering the facts that the investigation in the present case is complete; no recovery is to be made; challan stands presented; and conclusion of the trial is likely to take time; petitioner is granted bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
