Petitioner at the relevant time was serving as a Senior Auditor being aspirant to become an Assistant Accounts Officer took the State Accounts Service Part-II Examination held in August, 2011 wherein he was shown as unsuccessful having obtained 76 marks as against the minimum requisite of 80 marks to be qualified as an Assistant Accounts Officer to work in the State. This petition has been filed assailing his result.

2. Having heard the arguments of learned counsel for the parties, it appears that the case of the petitioner is hit by a judgment/opinion rendered by me qua the same selection process in ***CWP No.8170 of 2015*** titled as **Anil Kumar vs State of Haryana and others** decided on **18.04.2022**.
