The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case registered vide FIR No.107 dated 14.04.2022 under Sections 323, 324, 34, 341, 506 IPC (Section 326/201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Kaithal Sadar, District Kaithal.

The Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is undoubtedly the main accused who has been attributed the injuries attracting Section 326 IPC. He however, submits that two of the co-accused have been granted the concession of bail vide orders Annexure P-3 & P-4. He contends that the petitioner is in custody since 25.4.2022 and none of the

07 prosecution witnesses have been examined so far. Even otherwise it is a

case of sudden occurrence and the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents. He therefore prays for grant of regular bail.

The Counsel for the State on the other hand contends that the petitioner is the main accused and cannot claim parity with other to accused who have been granted bail. He thus contends that the present bail petition ought to be dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties at length.

Admittedly, the petitioner is in custody since 25.04.2022 and none of the 07 witnesses have been examined so far. Therefore, the trial in the present case is not likely to be concluded in near future. As such the further incarceration of the petitioner is not required.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-**Charan Singh** son of Sh. Sandokha is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
