Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 27.07.2021, under Sections 306, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 304-B IPC added and Section 306 IPC deleted vide order dated 02.04.2022), registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 28.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 28.04.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjeet Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.04.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
